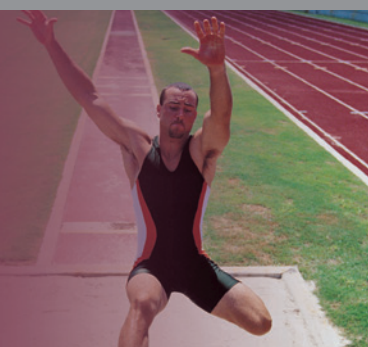


Minimum Requirements

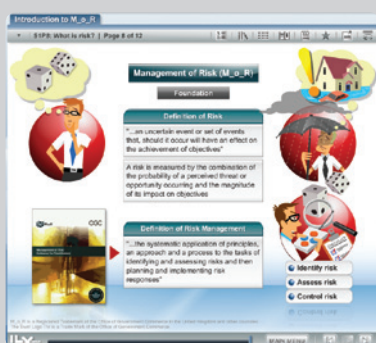

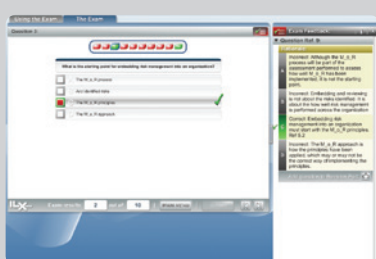
