

The PRINCE2® Re-Registration Exam Workshop (P2RW)



Certification in the PRINCE2® method has become the benchmark standard throughout the project management industry. The most desirable level of certification is the PRINCE2® Registered Practitioner qualification.

The PRINCE2® Manual is periodically revised and enhanced to reflect the latest best practices in project management and the most recent update was in June 2009. As a result, in order to maintain the status of PRINCE2® Registered Practitioner, certificate holders must re-take a re-registration exam every 3-5 years. This one hour examination ensures that registered practitioners are fully up to date with any revisions to the method and can evidence that their knowledge of the method is current.

This is the only qualification scheme aimed at Project Management professionals that is recognised by the UK Accreditation Service (UKAS) in accordance with the requirements of EN 45011 and EN 45013.

This course will provide a comprehensive overview of the recent changes and developments in the PRINCE2® method together with comprehensive and up to date guidance on examination technique. Candidates will take the PRINCE2® Practitioner Re-registration examination at the end of the workshop.



Course Content

This one-day workshop takes candidates through a review of PRINCE2® method and the changes thereto. Candidates are provided with:

- Practitioner preparation workbook
- PRINCE2® manual 5th edition 2009
- PRINCE2® changes document
- PRINCE2® re-registration exam

This re-registration comprises a one hour examination set at the same standard as the Practitioner examination. All Practitioners who have taken the PRINCE2® Practitioner qualification since October 2000 have agreed or are agreeing to this requirement as part of their initial application and so are now designated as Registered Practitioners.

Duration

This is a one-day workshop which is offered on an in-house and public basis

Accreditation

- A scenario-based objective testing exam
- Each of the three questions is worth 12 marks
- Minimum of 20 marks out of 36 required to pass
- One hour duration
- Open-book (Only the PRINCE2® manual is allowed)

Target Audience

- **Practitioners certified prior to October 2000** have the opportunity to take the re-registration examination in order to demonstrate their commitment to professional development. This is particularly important following the recent revisions to the PRINCE2® manual and its greater focus on Business Case and the Management of Risk.
- **Those who have qualified since January 2001** or have voluntarily undertaken the re-registration qualification are designated as Registered Practitioners, which enables employers and prospective employers to be confident with their recency of knowledge and commitment to Continuing Professional Development.
