

THIS MONTH IN PROJECT MANAGEMENT

We hope you agree that this month the hands-down winner has to be NASA's New Horizons spacecraft – which has made the first visit to Pluto, speeding past the dwarf planet at an amazing 14km per second. The probe was launched in 2006, and has travelled 2.95 billion miles. In that time it had to fly a perfect path past the planet, with perfect timing, in order to collect images: otherwise its cameras would shoot empty sky where the dwarf or its moons were expected to be. Therefore the probe had to remain within a keyhole



of space - 60 miles by 90 miles - and arrive at the location within a set of margins of 100 seconds over its nine year journey. It was **72 seconds early**.

What a feat of project management, leading to all that data and information to be analysed and learned from. Stunning!
