MAXIMISING ITIL VALUE WITH PRINCE 2

Government creates new body to deliver major UK projects

The UK Government has made a major announcement last week that Infrastructure UK (IUK) and the Major Projects Authority (MPA) will merge.

This new organisation, named as the Infrastructure and Projects Authority, will unite government capability under one roof. The change will be effective in January 2016, reporting jointly to the Chancellor and Minister for the



Cabinet Office, and its Chief Executive will be Tony Meggs, who is the current Chief Executive of the MPA. This will impact large projects such as, Crossrail, Thames Tideway Tunnel and Universal Credit.

Chancellor George Osborne said:

'By bringing together Infrastructure UK with the Major Projects Authority, and creating the new National Infrastructure Commission, we are moving to the next stage in our plan to ensure Britain's economy gets the transformational projects it needs.'
