THIS MONTH IN PROJECT MANAGEMENT?

On the 8th September 2016 NASA is launching the first US spacecraft that will study and return a sample of an asteroid.

This sample will help scientists understand how asteroids are made, how the solar system works and is formed, the nature of bodies in the solar system and it will benefit understanding of resources and hazards of the solar system.



Three quarters of the sample taken will be left for future scientists within NASA to conduct research on and answer questions that haven't even been asked yet. This seven-year project has been planned out and organised

by **Mike Donnelly**, Project Manager for OSIRIS-REx and works for **NASA Goddard**. He has been working with Universities to get high tech camera's for the spacecraft and organising, along with the scientists, each stage in this spacecraft's journey to asteroid Bennu and back to earth.

"Our upcoming launch is the culmination of a tremendous amount of effort from an extremely dedicated team of scientists, engineers, technicians, finance and support personnel,"

"I'm incredibly proud of this team and look forward to launching the mission's journey to Bennu and back." said Mike Donnelly, Project Manager, OSIRIS-REx

From this it is clear that a **Project Manager** has to lead the team, bringing them together in order to achieve their goal. It is also important to inspire a shared vision and being enthusiastic to keep the team motivated, for example the outcome for NASA will benefit this area of science for generations to come.
